AWAKENED TO THE GREATNESS OF GOD

(Psalm 145:1-9)

Intro: A "banner" over my heart and life for 2022

Key Verse: Psalm 145:3

Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised, and His greatness is unsearchable.

Main Idea: I'm free to be all about living a life of worship that pours out of the greatness of God.

Greatly TO be Praised: It's just who He IS (vs. 1-3)

They shall pour forth His fame: It's what worshipers DO (vs. 4-7)

The display of His greatness: It's what we tell the world! (vs. 8, 9)

His Greatness in Jesus and His Gospel

DISCUSSION & REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What stood out to you most from the message? Why?
- How would you describe your view of God's greatness? Does it impact you in practical ways?
- What stirs your heart from this passage and the rest of Psalm 145? How is God continually realigning your heart of worship?
- What are the ways you believe God wants to awaken your heart to a bigger view of Him and (as a result) a deeper trust in Him?
- Who is there in your life that God may be calling you to "extol His greatness" to? How might He bring up those opportunities this year? Will you commit to pray to that end?
