Ruth: Faithful God

Steps of Faith

(Ruth 3)

Backstory:

Kinsman redeemer: One who delivers or rescues. A male relative who had the privilege and responsibility to act on behalf of a relative who was in trouble, danger, or need. Deuteronomy 25:5-10, Leviticus 25:25-28, 47-49, Numbers 27:11

Scene 1: Naomi's plan (vs. 1-5)

Scene 2: A "risky" night on the threshing floor (vs. 6-13)

Scene 3: Waiting on the Lord without compromising (vs. 14-18)

DISCUSSION & REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What stood out to you most from the message? Why?
- What can you learn about the actions and character of Naomi, Ruth and Boaz?
- Do you agree or disagree with the statement that we are "risk averse" as a people? What do we learn from Ruth's risky steps? Where is the Lord calling you to step out in faith right now?
- When we are waiting on the Lord why is it important to not compromise? Where are you feeling the pressure to compromise in your life right now?
