MY Good Shepherd

(Psalm 23)

I shall not want vs. 1-3 (*Isaiah 40:10-11, John 10:1-18, Revelation 7:9-17*)

I will fear no evil vs. 4

- My Shepherd's PURPOSE in the valley (*2 Corinthians 1:8-11, Romans 5:1-5, 8:28-30*)
- My Shepherd's PRESENCE in the valley (*Psalm 73:23-28, Joshua 1:5, Isaiah 43:1-7*)
- My Shepherd's PROVISION in the valley (*Psalm 91, 19:5, 2 Peter 1:3*)

I will dwell with The Lord FOREVER! vs. 5-6 (*John 14:15-17, Revelation 21:1-4*)

DISCUSSION & REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What stood out to you most from the message? Why?
- What things do you "want" more than Jesus? What does it look like practically to spend regular time with Jesus to experience the rest, perspective, and satisfaction that is found in Him?
- What fears are you currently experiencing in the valley? How do the truths about God's purposes, presence, and provision give you perseverance in the valley?
- What "enemies" do you struggle with that try to keep you from dwelling at the table of God's fellowship? (i.e. doubt, discouragement, condemnation) What has Jesus done to overcome each of those enemies?
