(John 4:1-30)

Main Idea:

Christ graciously provides perfect satisfaction for our longings and reorients us to joyful mission

The Shocking Grace of Jesus

"How is it that you, a Jew, ask for a drink from me, a woman of Samaria?"

The Satisfying Gift of the Holy Spirit

"Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again"

The Reorienting Mission of God

"Come, see a man who told me all that I ever did. Can this be the Christ?"

DISCUSSION & REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What stood out to you most from the message? Why?
- How should remembering the free grace Christ gives us change how you treat others?
- What are ways that you tend to try to satisfy your spiritual thirst? How does that compare to what Jesus offers?
- Do you struggle to believe that you'll find satisfaction in Christ? How is this passage good news for you?
